### Camp Joy

Camp Joy welcomed this year over an hundred children/ youth for the April summer camps. The days were filled with fellowship, fun, bible studies and much more. Most of the campers come from Buddhist families so it is a blessing to see that the same campers were reading from the Bible now and singing songs about the Lord and some of them confessed their sins and invited Jesus Christ in their hearts.

The camp's theme this year was about the Holy Spirit. Together we first looked into subjects as God's majesty and power and our creation and sinfulness. The speakers explained the children more and more about the Holy Spirit and His work through reading and remembering Bible verses.



We received a visit from our partner organisation Woord en Daad from Holland. Mr. Geurt Versteeg and mr. Johan Groothedde from the finance department stayed with us on April 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> and came as internal auditors to give advice regarding the Organization Capacity Assessment. As it was only a few days before the Songkran water festival, we celebrated already as you see.

# Project Highlight: Emergency Relief Earthquake Myanmar

Every month we highlight one of AMG's projects and tell you something more about it

Myanmar was struck by a heavy earthquake on the 24<sup>th</sup> of March. Over 150 people were killed. A team from Bangkok went to Myanmar and gave emergency relief packages to more than 500 families. The first village where they arrived was Tar Kyant, near the epicentre of the quake. They handed out food, medicines and drinking water. Many people told them this was the first aid they received. It was five days after the earthquake struck! In the evening the village people met together and listened to sharing from the Gospel.



The following morning they travelled to (the Christian) Kya Ku Ni village where the church building was collapsed. 22 church members were killed. About 300 soldiers of the military were present to help clearing the fallen buildings. The team distributed more water and medicines and dried noodles to the villagers. Pastor Saung preached the Gospel in the evening and villagers and soldiers came to listen. At the end of the day some people including some soldiers asked and prayed together with the team for forgiveness of their sins.



The third village to visit was the Buddhist village of Wiang Lan. The team was welcomed warmly as well as the water and food which



were very much needed in the village. Many people were without homes. The team handed out Christian tracts and in the evening there was another meeting with prayer for forgiveness and healing.
