Time moves so fast when you are in the thick of a battle. This year's summer activities were filled with Vacation Bible School meetings reaching out to 2,488 participants at four centers. We shared with the

Studying the theme, "Valleys of the Bible," participants were challenged to depend on God's grace for their lives at all time. We recorded 232 new decisions for Christ at the end four weeks of VBS meetings. We were blessed by visiting team members from Florida and North Carolina. They brought gifts, craft items and study materials to

the participants and helped teach the Bible lessons with practical illustration and application. They also taught "*Beautiful From the Inside Out*" at the Women Conferences, and at our Church Worship Leaders' Workshop their message was "*Created for Communion With God.*"

We continue to travel to a variety of events and meetings. It is amazing to see children from the junior department at church grow to young adults and get married. I officiated two wedding ceremonies for members of our church—Elsie and Robert, and Fred and Sarah. I have two more weddings to officiate for Pastor Arthur and Paulina in Liberia and Jackling and Nana Addo at our church.

Public schools have reopened and we have begun our campus ministry. We have received 4,000 Bible lessons to distribute to students at the junior high schools while we wait for 6,000 more from the printer. The Bible lessons we teach the students at the campuses are really making a difference in their decisions on health, career, education and eternity. We have prayed and



counseled with several students at their schools, and it is a joy to see changed lives by being there to help them make appropriate relational decisions for their life.

The family is doing well. Ama is in 6th grade and the other day she talked about her friend at school who is not saved, and how she can witness to her. She also ask her friend to come to church with us.
