care of me and my family," writes little Ag\*, one of the precious boys and girls under AMG's care in Thailand whose life has been transformed by a loving donor like you who sponsored him. "...Every month the project will bring food and essential household items to me and my family, especially now that my mother is no longer at home with me... Please pray for me and everyone in my family," he continues.

Ag\* is just one example of fruit that God produced as you partnered with AMG to meet the deepest spiritual and physical needs of the lost and the suffering around the world. As we acted together in obedience to God's calling, He did some amazing things. These are just a few of the highlights:

- » The number of needy boys and girls cared for through AMG grew by more than 660.
- » More than 50 new church plants, including ones to unreached people groups, were started.
- » There was significant growth in pastor training outreaches, particularly in Africa and Asia.
- » Many souls came to know Jesus as Lord and Savior because of media evangelism efforts, including social media in Turkey and radio broadcasts in Indonesia.
- » Devastated individuals and families found help and hope, including earthquake victims in Turkey and refugees from Myanmar and Afghanistan. Not only that, but these relief efforts opened the doors for future ministry expansion in those regions.
- » Tens of thousands of children were reached through youth discipleship efforts in Ghana, Liberia, Togo, and Nigeria.
- » Construction of the new radiotherapy wing at St. Luke's was completed, and there were record numbers of patients searching for healing who experienced the love of Christ.

The Lord used us to accomplish marvelous things. But our task is not done. There are billions who are lost, and there is much turmoil around the world. The situation in the Middle East is very unstable, fighting continues in Ukraine and Myanmar, and the climate for Christians continues to worsen in many countries. Inflation and food instability remain problems for hundreds of millions in the areas in which we work. At the same time, the Lord continues to open doors, and together, we will press on to continue to make Him known. Some of the new opportunities that the Lord is presenting us with include:

- » Expand our ministries in the Philippines, Indonesia, Pakistan, and Myanmar.
- » Start additional church plants, including many more among unreached people groups.
- » Expand our pastor training programs in countries around the world, including training for faithful Iranian pastors.
- » Proclaim the love of Christ in Muslim populations in North Africa and the Middle East.
- » Expand our ministry in East Africa (Kenya, Tanzania, and Uganda), West Africa, Pakistan, and Colombia.
- » Engage in ministry among Farsi speakers in Greece.
- » Grow our outreach to Arab speakers through internet radio broadcasts.

Our God is at work! The gospel is as powerful today as ever, and you can continue to proclaim it. If you do that, God uses you to transform individuals, families, and entire communities. Thank you for your partnership! You are making a difference.

Katsarkas, Director of AMG's St. Luke's Hospital in Thessaloniki, Greece, and his beloved wife, Eunice, have been beacons of hope and inspiration to those who come to St. Luke's at a time of need.

"More people come through the doors of a hospital than a church," says Dr. Katsarkas. As a young doctor in Thessaloniki with a heart and a vision to share the love of Christ through medicine, Dr. Katsarkas envisioned a sanctuary where medical care would intertwine seamlessly with spiritual healing—a haven where the grace of Christ permeated every corridor. This God-given vision stirred passionately in his heart, and he remained steadfast in working to make it a reality despite the many challenges he faced.

In 1961, Dr. Katsarkas shared his dreams and aspirations with AMG President, Dr. Spiros Zodhiates, whose heart resonated with the same calling. Their like-minded passions gave birth to St. Luke's Hospital in Thessaloniki, which, after a modest beginning, would blossom into a bright light of hope.

In 1975, St. Luke's opened its doors with very few patients. However, within a short time, word began to spread in the local community and beyond. Almost 50 years later, St. Luke's serves thousands of people from all over the world each month, offering the highest level of modern medical services along with a tangible expression of the love of Jesus.

"I still remember the hospital's first


week of 'operation' when not a single patient showed up," reminisced Dr. Katsarkas, but soon, our corridors echoed with footsteps of those seeking solace. Our hearts overflowed with gratitude to God.

Over the decades, St. Luke's has evolved from a humble hospital into a state-of-the-art medical center with cutting-edge facilities spanning many specialties. Yet, amidst this remarkable growth, its foundation remains rooted in biblical principles and unwavering compassion.

In December of 2023, construction of the latest addition to the hospital, a radiotherapy wing, was completed. As a token of gratitude and admiration, the AMG Board of Directors dedicated this new wing to Mrs. Eunice Katsarkas—a steadfast companion and unwavering support to her husband throughout their journey. The Eunice Katsarkas International Center for Stereotactic Radiosurgery Radiotherapy is a testament to her enduring commitment and selflessness.

As Dr. Katsarkas and his wife traversed the halls of the new wing, their hearts swelled with gratitude. "How great are Thy works, O Lord," they exclaimed, humbled by the magnitude of God's faithfulness.

The hospital's motto is twofold: first, a quote from the Hippocratic Oath: "for the benefit of the sick"; then, the penultimate phrase of the hymn of love in the first Epistle to the Corinthians, as written by the Apostle Paul, "Greater than these is love."

#### **AMG'S BUGONGI COLLEGE OF NURSING**

and Midwifery in Uganda is an outstanding example of exceptional healthcare education in its region. The school pursues academic excellence and is transforming the lives of countless students who see themselves as "medical missionaries," sent out by the Lord to touch the lives of the sick with the love of Jesus. Each morning, they sing an anthem of how the Lord prepares them to heal the sick and win souls for Jesus. Their enthusiasm for the gospel is contagious and will undoubtedly impact thousands when they begin their careers as medical professionals.

The Bugongi College of Nursing was established in 2017 to meet Uganda's desperate demand for nurses. According to one report from the Uganda Minister of Health, there is just one nurse for anywhere between every 5,000 to 10,000 people. There has been much demand for its services, and the school has been expanding very rapidly. After much anticipation, in June of 2023, the new women's dormitory opened with the capacity to house an additional 200 nursing students, and the female students were incredibly excited. The new dormitory equips BCNM to accept even more students and meet the increasing demand. The old dormitory will be turned into much-needed additional classroom space.

Please pray for the student nurses at BCNM and that God will use them to touch lives with His love and bring forth physical and spiritual healing.



#### AFTER THE TWO EARTHQUAKES IN

Turkey in February 2023, 1.5 million people were without homes or jobs, and you made it possible for our national missionaries to respond immediately. Because of your faithful giving, tents and shipping containers were provided for temporary housing. For over five months, your support provided three meals daily to an average of 4,000-6,000 people.

A benefit to working with national missionaries who live in the areas they serve is that they know the deepest needs of those communities. After the earthquakes, they knew that having a community of people would comfort them in such a tragic time. AMG's national missionaries worked with a network of volunteers to create temporary housing communities, and they would deliver food to these families. While there, they would gather to eat their meals and drink tea together.

In the aftermath of the earthquakes, God has been producing plentiful fruit and has continued to advance the gospel in Turkey. The response to media evangelism efforts has been increasing in the days since the tragedy. The impact of the relief efforts is readily observable; what is most amazing is how spiritual needs have been met.

Through all these outreach efforts, people are experiencing the transforming love of Christ. Currently in Turkey, it is very challenging for new evangelical churches to obtain permits for facilities or to have public gatherings. While local authorities may be able to stop churches from renting buildings, they cannot stop God from building His church. Pray for these church groups as they continue to grow despite the challenges and as they advance the gospel in the midst of adversity.

## Equipping Tomorrow's Leaders



#### DIANA IS A REMARKABLE WOMAN WHO

loves children, particularly those experiencing poverty and brokenness. Growing up in a broken home in Kenya herself, she understands the struggles and challenges many of these precious little ones face. She wants them to experience the transformative love and grace of Jesus Christ and restore hope for the future in their lives. That is why Diana and her husband, Samuel, Director of AMG Kenya, started the Precious Zawadi Academy (PZA) in the town of Eldoret.

While growing up, Diana lived with her mother and grandparents, who were battling alcoholism, but amidst the chaos, she discovered a sanctuary within the walls of her high school. There, she encountered a group of Christians who shared the love of Christ with her. She began to find refuge in God's Word and saw how merciful He is.

Before PZA, Diana was teaching, but the cost of her commute to work was more than her pay. She prayerfully resigned, knowing God would provide what was next. Shortly after, Diana began to notice the local children at church did not attend school. Diana saw the need for a school to be within their community to give these children the opportunity to get an education. Diana wants all children to experience the same powerful, transforming love she found as a teenager.

As they noticed this deep need, Samuel and Diana met with their church and requested permission to open a school in the church. The church elders approved the request, and things came together quickly through the community, family, and amazing donors; Samuel and Diana had uniforms and shoes donated, and family and friends provided chairs, tables, and desks. Before their eyes, Precious Zawadi Academy came to fruition.

Precious Zawadi Academy began with ten children but quickly experienced a significant increase in enrollment. By 2023, the student population had grown to almost 300, with 165 sponsored by AMG donors. Samuel and Diana, motivated by compassion, continue to enroll marginalized children in PZA as they identify those in need. To handle this growth, temporary classrooms were added, and more land was acquired. Samuel and Diana are the hands and feet of Jesus for hundreds of children.

Diana witnesses firsthand the transformative power of God in the students' lives. She is deeply grateful to the donors and sponsors whose contributions have made such a profound impact, ensuring the children's spiritual and physical needs are met. Watching the children grow spiritually gives Diana and Samuel great fulfillment. In one recent example, students volunteered to recite Bible verses, songs, and poems to pastors undergoing training as part of AMG's pastor training program. These pastors were very moved by the children's dedication to the Lord.

In 2023, AMG Kenya was approved to be an official organization in Kenya, a step toward allowing them to pursue the opportunity to expand in the future. The goal for all the children at PZA is to receive a good education and biblical teaching so that they develop into successful adults. Diana wants PZA always to be known for instilling godly values and teaching the children the Word of God.

#### SO MANY OF THE PRECIOUS CHILDREN

born into families who live in extreme poverty in Guatemala grow up without ever having the opportunity to travel outside the village or town in which they are born. Even more tragically, many children grow up in areas where gang activity and crime are prevalent. Hardship, and even fear for their well-being, is what they experience daily as they try to survive.

But for those who become part of AMG's child and youth development program because of the generous sponsors, lives are transformed. As they are loved and cared for by AMG staff, they experience the love of Christ, and hope is restored in their lives. They could break out of the cycle of poverty and violence. The education they receive helps them prepare for the future, and they grow up learning biblical truths and are given a strong foundation in Christ. Through the care of their sponsor, along with their education, they have all their basic needs met with nutritious meals, medical needs, personal development, and spiritual training, and their entire lives are transformed.

All the children under AMG's care in Guatemala experience one more special blessing. As they reach the fifth grade, they travel and participate in AMG's Camp Canaan for a week. For some students, the camp setting differs significantly from their home community and life. Students from the city are used to hearing constant noise from all the traffic, hearing gunshots, and experiencing the trauma of gang violence.



For many AMG kids, visiting Camp Canaan is their first opportunity to run free in a safe, peaceful forest. In this setting, the children can reflect on their lives and hear God's quiet voice. Throughout their days at camp, the staff can see an ignited passion come alive in the campers. Camp Canaan operates 42 weeks of the year, serving thousands of students. Many alumni share that they came to know Christ through the camp ministry and found hope for their futures.

Luzbin is a sixteen-year-old student who attends AMG's Filadelfia development center in the Central Region of Guatemala. Last summer, Luzbin and his classmates took their annual trip to camp. Luzbin had been to camp before and was not anticipating anything different from previous years. But, as José Luis, the Director of Camp Canaan, began his biblical teachings, Luzbin began to feel more eager to learn about God. By the end of the week, Luzbin accepted Christ as his Savior. José Luis loves to watch the next generation leave the distractions of their daily lives and turn their attention to Jesus.

After returning from camp, Luzbin found a church and got involved immediately. He is so grateful God moved in his heart at camp. He says he will always see Camp Canaan as a second home. Luzbin said he dreams about his future and knows God has a plan for him. He plans to go into mechanics after high school. He would like to continue to a university to study Mechanical Engineering.



## Sustainable Blessings

THE JOURNEY OF RUT AND SARAH AMONG THE TOLAKI TRIBE



#### OF THE ALMOST 280 MILLION PEOPLE

among the thousands of islands of the Indonesian Archipelago, 70% live in tribes that have never been reached with the Good News. Many of these indigenous tribes remain isolated and marginalized, lacking access to the transformative message of the gospel. By introducing the gospel to these unreached tribes, our national missionaries offer them hope and salvation in Jesus and transform these communities.

At Berita Hidup, AMG's Seminary in Indonesia, the staff is committed to training the next generation to be theologically well-grounded in the Bible and deeply motivated to reach the lost. So many of these students are passionate about planting churches in unreached areas throughout Indonesia. Over the years, Berita Hidup has produced hundreds of graduates, most of whom serve as pastors and leaders of over 400 churches that have been planted.

In September 2023, Berita Hidup sent out the most recent crop of church planters to unreached tribes in Indonesia. Among these faithful servants are Rut and Sarah, who feel called to take the gospel to unreached people groups. As they tread treacherous paths to reach the Tolaki tribe, they carry herbal medicines for those in need while also bringing compassion and the promise of

redemption through Jesus. In a community marked by drunkenness, gambling, and broken families, Rut and Sarah are prayerfully getting to know the tribe and developing relationships.

They experience resistance from some, but not necessarily hostility. Some turn away, others scorn their efforts, but even with the skepticism, some are receptive to their message. Icana, a wife and mother, was lost and seeking truth. Because of Rut and Sarah's ministry, she has come to know Christ as Lord and Savior. She embraces her newfound faith despite her family and friends not supporting her decision. Icana excitedly attends Bible study with Rut and Sarah weekly, and she is a light in the community, pointing others to Jesus. Rut and Sarah are prayerful for God to open doors for Icana to share the gospel with other tribe members.

Rut and Sarah praise God, knowing heaven is rejoicing over Icana coming to know the Lord, but their mission is far from over. With less than 2% of the Tolaki tribe being followers of Jesus, they are considered an unreached people group. Rut and Sarah are passionate about reaching them and changing that characterization. They know that God can transform communities through the love of Christ including the Tolaki. As they continue their journey, pray for Rut and Sarah to continue to boldly proclaim the gospel.

THE UNSEEN IMPACT OF AMG'S GOAT INITIATIVE ON PASTORS AND COMMUNITIES

Nyanza, pastors, passionate with a calling to serve the Lord, must also provide for their physical needs and those of their families. A new initiative made possible by generous donors of AMG International has been transformative in the lives of these faithful pastors and their communities

Pastor Samuel, a national missionary in Kenya, found his life touched by this initiative eleven months ago when he received a dairy goat through the AMG International goat project. Little did he know that this animal would become a blessing not only for him but for his entire community.

"I have had the dairy goat for eleven months now," Pastor Samuel reflects with gratitude. "The goat gave birth, and after four months, I gave it to another pastor as a first-generation goat." "I want to thank God for this project.

The goat has saved our family money from not needing to buy the products and allows me to travel farther to minister to more people."

The goat has been a lifeline for Pastor Samuel and his family. "The dairy goat has benefited my family; she provides milk for our daily use and extra to sell. There is a flow of cash that was not there before. The milk is nutritious, not processed, and ideal for human consumption. I am grateful to have such a blessing, now that I have children who still need to be cared for with a proper balanced diet."

The impact of the goat project extends beyond the confines of Pastor Samuel's home. His community's need for goat milk was high, and the surplus was shared with neighbors. "We even share the goat's waste products with the people around, which is the best organic manure for our backyards or gardens. In the future, the goat project will also enhance food supply for families and communities."

Pastor Samuel's story of the difference a goat can make is one of many. The goat project is transforming the lives of many pastors, their families, and entire communities. It provides a livelihood and benefits many others. As they pray for the continuation and expansion of this initiative, the hope is that many more pastors will experience the benefits, allowing them to dedicate more time to their ministries while ensuring the well-being of their families and communities. The goat project is more than a milk provider; it is also an avenue of sustainable development and community support.


REACHING THE UNREACHABLE

evangelism through media such as newspapers, radio, and, more recently, the internet to take the Good News to hard-to-reach places. These areas are traditionally closed to the gospel or with very few Christians. The goal of media evangelism is to connect those who respond to the gospel advertisements or broadcasts to pastors and communities of believers in their regions to introduce them to Jesus and help them on their spiritual journeys.

As technology advances, engaging with various audiences effectively through media evangelism is always taking new forms. From printed publications and traditional radio, our media evangelism partners have been adapting to innovative approaches to sharing the gospel. Using various existing methods and looking for new ones allows us to stay connected and reach individuals where they are.

An AMG national missionary, Mrs. Kanokporn shared how impactful media evangelism has been as a method for sharing the gospel in Thailand. In the last six months of 2023, AMG Thailand focused on utilizing social media to share the Good News. In a region deep-rooted in Buddhist traditions, Christian churches are scarce or completely non-existent in some areas. With a majority of people having access to and utilizing social media, digital gospel content can reach a broad audience, offering hope and a sense of community in this virtual space.



The Lord has always helped AMG Thailand enjoy great success in enrolling individuals in Bible correspondence courses. One particular area where there are a lot of individuals who are learning and growing from these Bible correspondence courses is prisoners. Mrs. Kanokporn shared that the jails have been requesting more and more of the courses. She shares, "Please pray for those in jail that they see the light and are delivered from the darkness. Pray they understand the meaning of the gospel and accept Jesus Christ as their Savior. We hand our future to God and trust the Holy Spirit will work."

With your prayerful support, the media evangelism outreach is seeing wonderful results in one of the most difficult places for the gospel. The seed of the gospel is being sown widely among Buddhists in Thailand. Pray that many will come to a saving knowledge of Jesus as they learn about Him.

visited many of our projects in Uganda in March of 2023, including a new concept within our child & youth development ministry. Historically, AMG has entered new communities slowly, working towards having a school or after-school facility where we can invest in children's spiritual and physical lives.

This past year, with the support of our long-time partners, Word & Deed Netherlands, we piloted what has become a very successful education project in a very short period. Rather than building a costly facility, we established an office and collaborative space within a public school to sponsor needy children from a challenged community. Within this space, we can work with the children and their families to ensure their needs are met, provide tutoring and educational support, offer food and healthcare support, and even support single mothers with economic development opportunities.

While Brian was walking through a crowd of nearly 2,000 students, one young man greeted him. To his surprise, his name was also Brian. What are the chances of that? In conversation, they learned he was an AMG-sponsored child. He shared how much he enjoyed school and how grateful he was for the support and the opportunity to attend through the support of a family that lived so far from him.


